For thirty-two years, the Missouri Peace Officers Foundation has focused our efforts on keeping children safe through initiatives such as our 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Essay Contest. This year's essay contest topic reflects on: "Concerns About Recreational Marijuana/THC Use and Driving"

The MPOF will award a total of \$1,600 in cash prizes to contestants who will be judged by a panel of top Missouri law enforcement professionals. The prizes will be awarded in the spring of 2024 honoring the top winners and their school from both the east and west sides of Missouri.

We urge participating schools to make this an interdisciplinary event, encouraging classes to research information and discuss the impact on the use of Marijuana/THC and its dangers to individuals, families, and the community.
